FEEES FOR SUMMER SCHOOL WILL VARY

Princess Anne High School will be the summer school site for **Princess Anne, Bayside, and Cox High School** students. Summer school fees are currently being reevaluated. Students who have a completed free/reduced lunch form

on file and have been determined eligible for reduced price or free meals during the regular school year are also eligible to receive reduced summer school tuition in all high school summer programs except enrichment programs. Parents or guardians who would like the school to determine their child's eligibility for free and reduced tuition **must sign the release section of the registration form**. This will permit school officials to assess the necessary information to award the tuition benefit.

NOTE: FREE/REDUCED LUNCH FORM APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE FILLED AT THE STUDENT'S HOME SCHOOL BY JUNE 13, 2008.

Summer school regular register will take place June 18th and 19th at the designated summer school sites from **8:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon**. **Students enrolling in a credit bearing course for the first time must complete a 30 day instructional program equal to one year of instruction in the regular school year (two semesters in length) to receive a full credit.** Students repeating a course they have previously failed may earn credit by completing a 15 day (one semester) program to receive credit. **If the repeat course is not offered in a 15 day format, student may elect to take the 30 day course offering.**
