

## Morning Traffic Problems- How YOU can help!

As most of you know, entering and exiting into Princess Anne High School each morning is very difficult and sometimes dangerous for our students, as well as our drivers. Traffic is backed up on Cavalier Stadium Drive due to a number of reasons. Drivers stop to drop-off students, drivers enter and then try to exit the church parking lot, and students are crossing in front of cars and buses. This backup causes traffic to back up on Virginia Beach Boulevard because drivers cannot make a left into the school.

Princess Anne High School officials have worked with the police and officials from Thalia Lynn Baptist Church to help resolve some of these issues. Please read the following directions to help our traffic flow better.

- Parents who are dropping off students will be required to proceed down Cavalier Stadium Drive and make the first right into the Senior Parking Lot. Cars will proceed down the first lane, turn left and proceed back up the second lane. Students can be dropped off in this second lane of the Senior Parking Lot. **See map below.** *Exiting drivers are reminded that the Middle Traffic Lane is reserved for buses in the morning.*
- Cars will not be able to enter Thalia Lynn Baptist Church parking lot. Cones will be added to block this exit. Student drop-off on church property is no longer an option. We want to be good neighbors, so please respect the church's private property.
- Virginia Beach Police Officers will be patrolling the Silver Diner and Chick Fila Parking Lot. Drivers who use these parking lots and the red light to simply cross directly into Princess Anne High School will be ticketed. This is a violation of the law.
- Please follow the instructions of our Security Assistants. They are trying to make your morning commute a little easier and a little quicker. Thanks for your support!
