Grade 9	Month	Action
	March	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Train mentors</li> <li>• Provide Personal Project Guide Present via PowerPoint basic information</li> </ul>
	May/June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Personal Project Team (PPT) assigns and distributes mentors to students</li> <li>• Meet (student) several times with mentor</li> <li>• Select a topic (student)</li> <li>• Begin Process Journal (student)</li> <li>• Second Week: Present Personal Project to students in English classes</li> <li>• Third or Fourth Week: Present Personal Project to parents at an Open House at PA</li> </ul>
	July/August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Finalize topic (student)</li> <li>• Begin preliminary investigation of the topic</li> </ul>
Grade 10	September	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Turn in final topic during the second day of English</li> <li>• Use practice assessments for training</li> </ul>
	October 10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Finish Rough Draft(I-Search Format) and turn in to mentor and English teacher</li> </ul>
	December	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Turn in early completed projects (I-Search Format) to mentors by December 20<sup>th</sup> and receive an incentive</li> </ul>
	January	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Turn in completed project to mentor by January 15<sup>th</sup></li> <li>• Request monitoring for March from IBO</li> </ul>
	February	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Turn in PP failure notice to PPT by February 7<sup>th</sup></li> <li>• Begin second assessment by PPT</li> </ul>
	May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Present Personal Projects at PP Café Night</li> </ul>
	June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Convene PPT to review process and make necessary changes</li> </ul>

### Notes:

1. IBO offers monitoring from September through March 15<sup>th</sup>. Requests must be submitted two months in advance.
2. Monitoring will be optional the first year for submission.
3. Students will turn in the Title page, Table of contents, Introduction, Description of the process, and Bibliography/Works Cited to English 10 teachers for a grade during the months of September and October. Jacquie Davis will provide necessary dates.
